Street Cleaning of the Season

The November snowstorm and subsequent freezing weather made it impossible for the mechanized sweepers to sweep areas F, G, H, J, and K of the street sweeping districts (please see attached). Since December 1, 1997 the Department of Public Works has embarked in a systematic campaign of cleaning streets in those areas. Leaf Vacuums, mechanical sweepers, and DPW personnel have been dispatched to those areas.

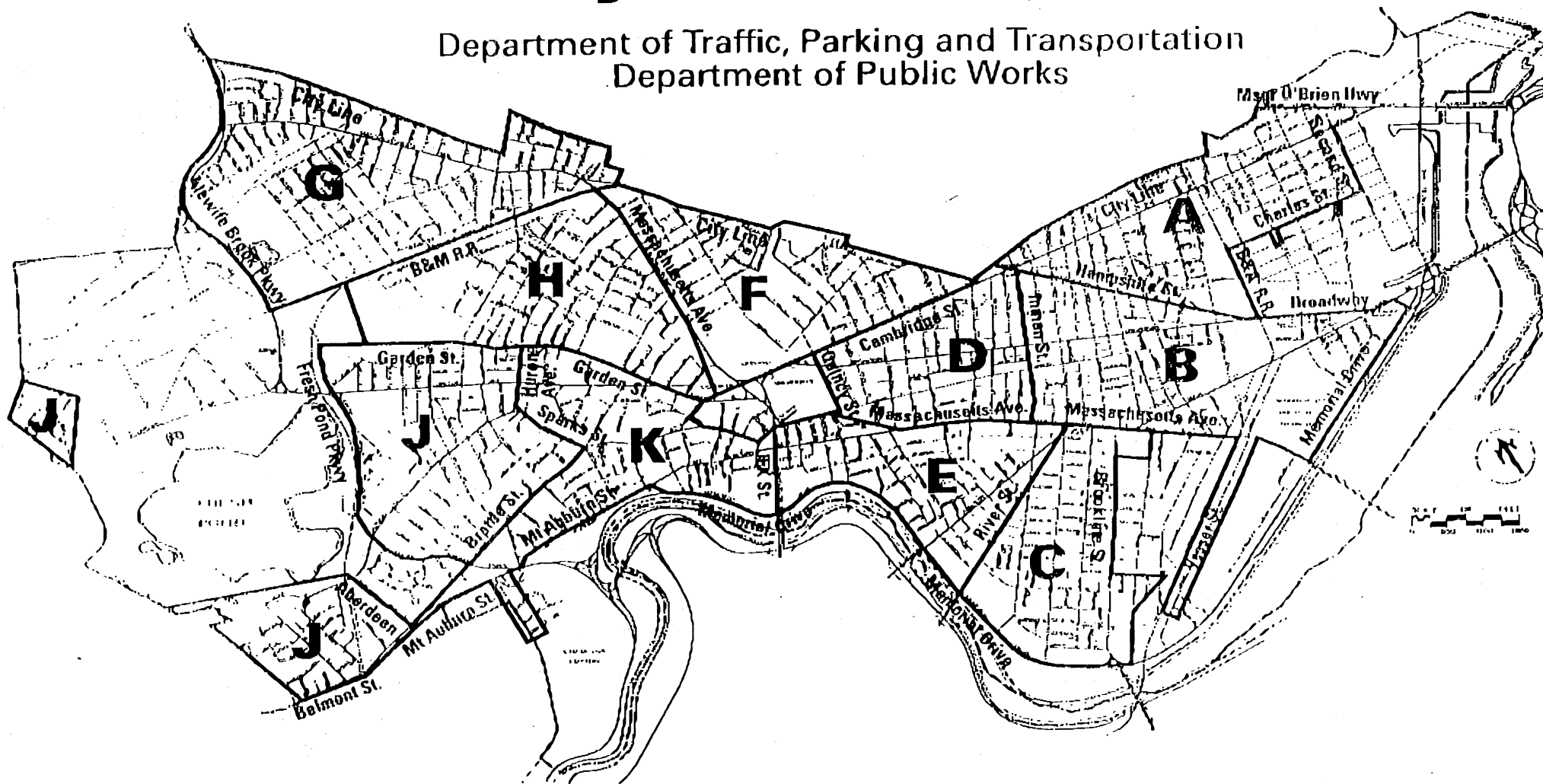
"No Parking" for sweeping signs have been posted in some areas. While no towing of vehicles has occurred, the Department will continue to employ the above mentioned techniques while the weather is favorable to ensure our City streets are free and clear of debris and leaves.

Street Sweeping Districts City of Cambridge

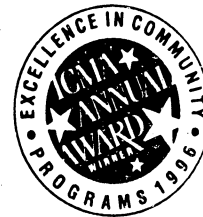
