Upon request of the hotel and Forest City Development, the Boys Choir of Harlem is scheduled to give a short performance for the people of Cambridge at Market Square Park – located at the corner of Sidney Street and Massachusetts Avenue on Saturday, December 19th at 1:30 p.m.

Conductor
The Boys Choir of Harlem was established by Dr. Walter J. Turnbull as a positive, creative alternative for inner city children from New York's five boroughs and has now grown into a conservatory-like, artistic and humanitarian institution. The Boys Choir of Harlem is currently involved in numerous projects including their present smash hit album "Up in Harlem". Their musical passage has also led them to two Grammy winning records – "Glory" and "A Soulful Celebration". In addition, the group released "Tis the Season", their new Christmas album featuring guest appearances by the First Lady, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Jewell, and Brian McKnight. The Choir is presently working on their first Christmas special.

The Choir has been seen on CBS's "60 Minutes", ABC's "Nightline", and NBC's "The Apollo Hall of Fame".
