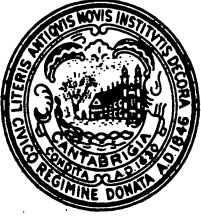


To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find two loan orders totaling \$1,000,000. The first loan order of \$750,000 is for the repair and reconstruction of streets and sidewalks in Non-Block Grant Neighborhoods. As you are aware, federal regulations prohibit the use of Block Grant Money in Non-Block Grant Neighborhoods.

The second loan order, totaling \$250,000 is for the acquisition and development of open space in Non-Block Grant Neighborhoods. The site(s) of the open space project(s) will be determined at a later date and will be based upon eligibility to obtain supplemental funding.

Passage of these orders is strongly recommended.
