

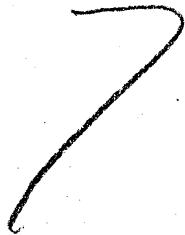

IN CITY COUNCIL

November 14, 1955.

WHEREAS:-

It is adjudged necessary for the public convenience and the public health that a main drain or common sewer should be laid out, made, constructed and maintained in certain public ways as follows:-

Extension of present sanitary and storm sewer in Concord Avenue beginning at the end of present sewer which is 300 feet westerly from Moulton Street for a distance of 100.0 feet more or less in a westerly direction.

it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the main drain or common sewer be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and the Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and instructed to cause the said main drain or common sewer to be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and to report to this City Council after completion of the work the cost thereof and assessments shall be made as provided by law upon the abutting estates as follows:-
