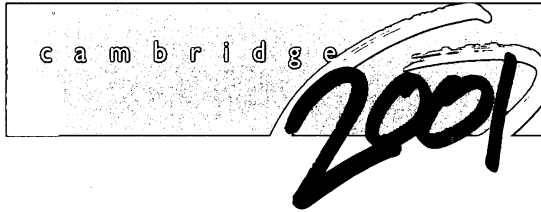

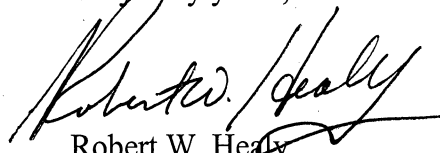

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$110,000 in the Public Investment Fund of the Community Development Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account from Free Cash. This will supplement \$100,000 of previously appropriated funds for the purpose of retaining a consultant team to carry out the completion of the Riverside planning study, working with the Riverside Study Committee and city staff. This study will update the 1992 neighborhood study, analyze potential future growth in the neighborhood, and recommend zoning and non-zoning measures to address planning concerns identified during the study process.
