IN CITY COUNCIL

June 26, 1989

ORDERED: That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Tina Graham, Owner and Operator of Desjarmes Clothing for the purpose of conducting a display of merchandise to be held the sidewalk at 10 Magazine Street, Cambridge, for the period of July 13, 14 and 15, 1989, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk at said premises, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.
