WHEREAS: While there are many heroes during those hours of panic the actions of a particular individual stands out. The calm, cool and methodical response of John Culhane of Littleton was beyond heroic as he helped shuttle people to safety from the building; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record offering its sincere thanks and debt of gratitude to John Culhane; and be it further
