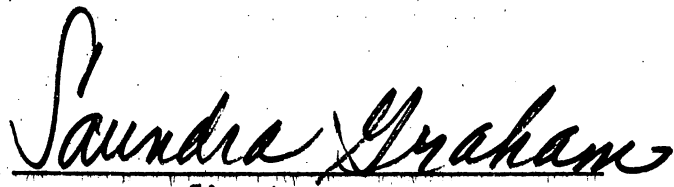
MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION SUBMITTED BY COUNCILLOR

Councillor Graham has notified the City Clerk of her intention to move Reconsideration of the vote of the City Council taken on June 15, 1987, adopting an order introduced by Councillor Walsh, in connection with the so-called "War on Gangs in Central Square", requesting the City Manager to set up meetings with parents; that outreach programs be employed; the Cambridge Auxiliary Police be called to assist; that potential resources of both the Harvard and M.I.T. Security Police be considered and that if the Police deem it necessary to make arrests, that they be informed they will have broad-based support.

WHEREAS:

There have been numerous meetings in the City of Cambridge regarding the so called "War on Gangs in Central Square", neighborhood meetings, a Central Square Association Meeting and a hearing by Cambridge City Council on June 1, 1987; and

WHEREAS:

It is the sense of City Council that a strong police presence or visability should be evident in Central Square, it is recognized that the Cambridge Police Department is to be thanked for their efforts to combat the Central Square crime wave and assaults but some additional measures would be helpful particularly now and during the summer; now therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be respectfully requested to arrange to have meetings set up with parents, that outreach programs be employed, that the Cambridge Auxilliary Police be called upon to assist, that the potential resources of the Harvard and M.I.T. Security Police be considered and that if the police, in their objective professional judgement, deem it necessary to make arrests that they be informed that they will have broad based support.
