- WHEREAS: Since the return of Harvard and Radcliff College students in the Shepard Street, Walker Street and Avon Street area the neighborhood has become flooded with students' cars which do not have parking permits for the area; and
- WHEREAS: The result of this influx of university student cars is that Cambridge residents do not have a place to park their cars at night in these areas; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Chief of Police to have his Police Officers give parking tickets every night from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. in this area for the month of October in order to enforce permit parking in the area and to allow Cambridge residents to have a place to park their cars.
