The last application filing date is November 21, 1997.** The Department is seeking highly qualified applicants who will maintain our mission of "Excellence in Service through Quality Policing." Women and minority candidates are especially encouraged to apply.

The Massachusetts State Police is the oldest statewide law enforcement agency in the nation. It was established in 1865. The Department uses the latest state of the art equipment and training in carrying out its law enforcement functions and activities.

Basic duties of a Trooper include patrolling the roadways of the Commonwealth, enforcing motor vehicle laws, engaging in crime prevention and reduction measures, preserving the peace and providing protection to the public. In addition, troopers may also perform specialized law enforcement functions which include but are not limited to:

- Piloting fixed wing or rotary aircraft while conducting aerial pursuits and searches for wanted and missing persons.
- Performing underwater search and rescue missions.
- Defusing crises involving hostages and suicidal individuals.
- Utilizing canines in conducting searches to detect narcotics and or explosive devices.
- Special Tactics and Operations Teams (STOP)
- Conducting criminal investigations.
- Conducting horseback patrol in State/MDC parklands.
- DARE community education programs.
