Order to Construct Main Drainage or

WHEREAS:-

It is hereby adjudged necessary for the public convenience and the public health that a main drain or common sewer shall be laid out, made, constructed and maintained in certain public way as follows:-

McCarthy Road from Flagg Street to Cowperthwaite Street,
about 320 feet.

and it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the said main drain or common sewer be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid, and the City Engineer is hereby authorized and instructed to cause the said main drain or common sewer to be made and constructed as aforesaid, the expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Sewer Construction - General.
