OBITUARIES

Father Francis Hagerty, Jesuit priest, teacher, 80

Father Francis Owen Hagerty, a Jesuit priest and teacher, died Thursday at Campion Center in Weston following a lengthy illness. He was 80.

Born in Dorchester, he graduated from Boston College High School. He entered the Jesuits in 1936.

He studied liberal arts at Shadowbrook in Lenox. He later studied philosophy and theology at Weston College, where he was ordained to the priesthood in 1949.

The Rev. Hagerty taught mathematics and computer programming at Boston College High School. He spent 15 years in Jamaica, doing pastoral work and teaching

math at St. George's College. He also acted as dean of the Extension School.

In 1969, he worked in the ministry at St. Pius Church in Milton.

The Rev. Hagerty is survived by his brother, Vincent of Abington; a half-brother, Paul of North Carolina; a half sister, Mary Tarrant of Michigan; several nieces and nephews; and a grandnephew.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. today at Campion Center, Weston.

Burial will be in the Jesuit Cemetery, Weston.
