An Ordinance

In addition to "An Ordinance providing for
the appointment and prescribing the duties
of City Marshall and establishing a City
Watch"

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge as follows:

Sec I The Mayor and Aldermen shall
annually appoint such a number of Police
men as they shall deem necessary who shall
perform all duties required of them in
the capacity of Day and Night Police in
accordance with the Laws of the Common-
wealth, and the Ordinances of the City under
such rules and regulations as the Mayor
and Aldermen may from time to time
prescribe

Sec II The compensation of said Police
men shall be one dollar and seventy
five cents per day, payable monthly, and

all fees received by said Policemen in the discharge of their duties, shall be paid into the City Treasury monthly, previous to receiving their compensation

Sec III The Mayor and Aldermen may also appoint such a number of Special Policemen as they shall deem needful and necessary who shall be subject to all the rules and regulations prescribed by the Mayor and Aldermen, and shall not be entitled to any compensation for their services, except it be otherwise ordered by the Mayor and Aldermen, and ^{who} shall pay all fees by them received for Police duties into the City Treasury

Sec IV The Mayor and Aldermen may appoint such number of Constables for the service of Civil Process as they shall deem proper who shall be qualified by giving Bonds according to Law which Constables shall be entitled to all fees received by them for the service of Civil Process, ^{but} ~~and~~ all fees received by them for services in Criminal Cases shall be paid into the City Treasury

Sec V All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed in Common Council March 6. 1856.
