The City Council by order adopted on February 4, 1980 requested to be notified of the expiration date of the Office of the City Clerk.


Since the present City Clerk was elected on May 19, 1975 to a three year term commencing June 1, 1975, the three year term would have expired on May 31, 1978 and the present incumbent would be a holdover since that date.

Under General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 12, the term of office of the City Clerk shall be three years from the date of his election or appointment.

The General Ordinances, Section 2-30, provides that the City Council shall elect a City Clerk in May who shall hold office for three years from the first of June in the year of his election and until his successor is elected and qualified.

In view of the above, an election for a new term for the City Clerk would be in order at any time and the term would commence as of June first in the year of the election for a three year term as outlined above.
