- WHEREAS: The parents request that morning speeding in the area be stopped and further that a school crossing guard be placed at the Rindge Avenue entrance of Jefferson Park to monitor the many school children awaiting school busses along Rindge Avenue; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Cambridge School Department, Chief Paolillo and Mr. George Teso, Department of Traffic & Parking regarding the speeding on Rindge Avenue, near Rindge Towers and Jefferson Park and report back on his disposition of this matter within two weeks.
