- WHEREAS: Dick was affectionately given the nickname "The Monster," for his tenacity on the mound as a relief pitcher; and
- WHEREAS: Dick was a member of the Boston Red Sox Hall of Fame; and
- WHEREAS: Dick was a former on-air personality for WEEI-AM (850) sports radio; and
- WHEREAS: Dick was a former pitching coach for the North Shore Spirit of the independent Northeast League; and
- WHEREAS: Dick's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife, Charlene (Booton), his former wife, Sharon (Cooper), his son, Richard R. Jr., his daughters, Leigh Radatz and Kristine Walworth, and his two grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS: Dick will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
