WHEREAS:

For the past quarter of a century, no group, organization or community has been willing to sponsor a bloodmobile on Thanksgiving Day, and

WHEREAS:

This year, in a spirit of service to the community, the Cambridge YMCA in conjunction with the Cambridge Chapter of the American Red Cross, will sponsor a community bloodmobile and brunch at the YMCA, Thanksgiving Day from 8:00 A. M. to 1:45 P. M., and

WHEREAS:

It is imperative that this bloodmobile be successful because the blood that is drawn will be the only fresh whole blood available for treatment of leukemia patients, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That realizing the urgency of the blood drive, I am proclaiming Thursday, November 28, 1974 "Blood Neighbor Day" with the firm belief that the people of this community will join in force on this life-saving mission.
