An Ordinance

Establishing the Salary of the Chief of Police.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

From and after the first Monday in January in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Eight, the Salary of the Chief of Police shall be Eight Hundred Dollars annually, payable in equal quarterly payments, which shall be in full for all services rendered by him in his official capacity.
