In an effort to keep the City Council informed about the progress and developments in the Commonwealth Electric Company's substation and 115 KV line project, this is to advise you that ComElectric officials are meeting with the tenants of the properties in question on Wednesday, October 26th at 4:00 P. M. in the Secretary of Consumer Affairs Office at 1 Ashburton Place. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the feasibility of actually moving both residential buildings to another site and thus not alter the number of rent-controlled units in the City.

Additionally, engineering studies are continuing for potential alternate routes for the transmission lines.

I will continue to keep the City Council informed on the progress of the project.
