WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge proudly enters its fifth year as a Sister City with San Jose Las Flores, a repopulated community in rural El Salvador; and

WHEREAS: The relationship between Cambridge and San Jose Las Flores has blossomed and enriched the institutions and citizens of each community; and

WHEREAS: Ruth Navidad is visiting Cambridge as a representative of the Christian Committee for the Displaced in El Salvador (CRIPDES), the organization which supports the efforts of the people of Las Flores to rebuild their community and live in peace; and

WHEREAS: Ruth Navidad, a leader of the popular movement, has worked tirelessly for the rights of those displaced by the war in El Salvador to land, education, health, and dignity; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council extends its warmest welcome to Ruth Navidad as she visits Cambridge to bring news of the movements for peace with justice in El Salvador; and be it further

RESOLVED: That this City Council sends through Ruth a message of hope for a peaceful settlement of the war and a commitment to work with the people of San Jose Las Flores in the reconstruction of their village and homeland.
