WHEREAS:

The Cambridge City Council has gone on record in opposition to transferring an all alcoholic beverage license to 10-12 Brookline Street due to the number of similar establishments already in the same area, and

WHEREAS:

Neighborhood residents, civic groups and area churches have also opposed such a transfer, and

WHEREAS:

The intent of this order and of the Council's prior order is not to impugn the character of any applicant, but rather to confirm our desire to improve and upgrade Central Square by discouraging an undue concentration of bars, fast food establishments and other all alcoholic licenses in one area, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Cambridge City Council is opposed to the application now before the License Commission to transfer an all alcoholic license to 10-12 Brookline Street.
