Dear Mr. Curry:

This matter was taken up with Mr. Ernest Graves of the Cambridge Electric Light Company who contacted Mr. Fantini, the occupant of No. 8 Leonard Avenue. Mr. Graves discussed a new location with Mrs. Fantini which was agreed to by her with the understanding that if her husband did not approve same he would get in touch with Mr. Graves within a specified time.

The Cambridge Electric Light Company will petition this commission for a relocation of the pole in question as soon as it is able to obtain written permission from Mr. Fantini to cross the corner of his property with a wire from the newly located pole for service to No. 10 Leonard Avenue.

When said petition is received by this commission, a date will be set for the hearing.

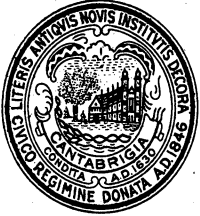




