

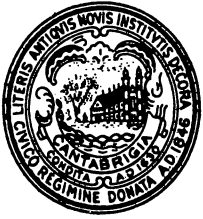

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find for your review and action two (2) orders requesting the transfer and appropriation of funds within and to the Election Commission budget.

The first order requests the transfer of \$16,525.00 from the department's Salaries and Wages account to the department's Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$176.00) and to the Extraordinary Expenditures Account (\$16,349.00).

The second order requests the appropriation of \$55,920.00 to the department's Extraordinary Expenditures account financed through tax dollars.

The result of these two actions will enable the Election Commission to lease votomatic demonstrator units and the necessary accessories for the September 18, 1984 primary election, and the purchase of New Harris type Votomatic Voting Devices (format 235) and the necessary accessories for the November 6, 1984, general election.

This lease/purchase action will allow the electorate to become familiar with this new equipment in September so as to ensure a smooth transition to this new voting method in November.

Passage of these orders is recommended.
