- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Emily B. Lewis will soon be honored by Syria Court Number 10 of the Daughters of Isis with a recognition ceremony on Sunday, November 14, 1982; and
- WHEREAS: Daughter Emily became Illustrious Commandress of Syria Court in 1960 and in 1961 she was appointed Imperial Deputy of the Desert of Massachusetts, serving in that position for five years; and
- WHEREAS: Daughter Emily was awarded the Past Imperial Commandress Degree at the National Convention held in St. Louis, Missouri in 1964; and
- WHEREAS: Daughter Emily has devoted many years of her adult life to the Daughters of Isis, as well as serving the people of Brookline as a Staff Nurse for thirty-eight years at the Brookline Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Upon her retirement from the hospital Daughter Emily became active as a member of the Cambridge Council on Aging and as a member of the Board of Directors of the Somerville Elder Service; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to Daughter Emily Lewis as she is honored by her many friends and associates for her dedicated and faithful work; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Daughter Emily Lewis on behalf of the entire City Council.
