To the Honorable, the City Council;

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$1 million for the Capital Fund in the Public Works Department's Extraordinary Expenditures Account for the Area IV Youth Center. The financing of this appropriation will come from free cash.

The availability of a facility within the Area IV neighborhood for area youth will not only address the need of those currently not being served in existing programs, but will enable the City to develop programs and activities to address the critical issues facing youth today. This facility will offer the opportunity to enjoy safe and supervised activities, while practicing teamwork and cooperation. Attached is a proposed design/construction schedule.

The proposed site, 243 Harvard Street, is located adjacent to Sennott Park which provides the following recreational resources: basketball courts, a softball field and a tot lot. In order to ensure maximum use of the facility, the City will closely follow the Gately Youth Center model which incorporates programs and activities for all ages and abilities. The preliminary scope of design includes space for a gym, multi-purpose rooms, a kitchen and an afterschool classroom.
