MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that, because of the budgetary constraints, the Metropolitan District Commission may not have enough police and maintenance crews to cover adequately the upcoming Head of the Regatta; and
- WHEREAS: If this immense race is not handled well and there is a spillover, the problems will impact the citizens of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager investigate police, traffic, and maintenance measures that will be taken to assure himself that they are adequate; and be it further
- ORDERED: That if he feels they are inadequate, he should take whatever measures that are necessary to insure that Regatta officials hire sufficient staff to deal with the problems.
