In the year One thousand Eight Hundred and
Seventy Five,

An Ordinance regulating the matter of Carriage Hire
by the City Council or Committee thereof,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge as follows,

No carriages shall be furnished at the
expense of the city, except on an Order
thereof signed by the Mayor, the President
of the Common Council, or the Acting
Chairman of any committee of either
Board of the City Council; said orders
to state the purpose for which the
carriages were required, and to accompany
the bill therefor as ^a vouchers.
