

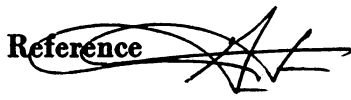

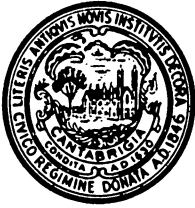
Subject Elderly Housing Otis and Sciarappa Street.

The street lights located adjacent to and accross from the building have been increased from 175 watt to 400 watt Mercury Vapor.

The Cambridge Housing Authority repaired the broken lights at the buildings main entrance.

These steps have signigicantly increased the lumination at the building entrance and the general area.
