RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Corporal Justin J. Watts at this time of such personal loss; and be it further

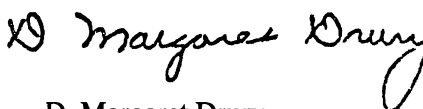
