COUNCILLOR DAVID SULLIVAN

ORDERED: That in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Division of Land Use of the Massachusetts Department of Food and Agriculture for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue at the corner of Norfolk Street on Mondays from July 1, 1982 up to and including October 26, 1982 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. for the purpose of holding a Farmers Market.

Provided that before erecting the above named banner the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to waive all parking fees for the meters within the parking lot located on Bishop Richard Allen Drive and Norfolk Street and the surrounding areas for the purpose of allowing consumers to participate in the Farmers Market during the period when the market is being conducted and to take whatever steps are necessary, including the posting of signs, to ensure that the intent of this order is being carried out.
