RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward suitably engrossed copies of this resolution to all concerned parties.

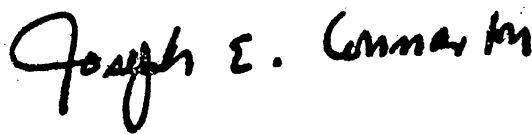
