- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has experienced dramatic increases in real estate values in the last two years; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has a large population of elderly and widowed who were receiving assistance through the abatement process; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has always supported the deserving residents in their hour of need; and
- WHEREAS: The current abatement regulations exclude many homeowners from tax relief under Massachusetts General Law; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Board of Assessors in conjunction with the City Solicitor to explore the possibility of filing Home Rule legislation to amend the current abatement regulation.
