WHEREAS: Edward Sarasin, a native of North Cambridge, graduated from Boston State College with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education and received a Masters Degree in Mathematics from Boston College; and

WHEREAS: Edward Sarasin began teaching in Cambridge as a math teacher in the Rindge Technical School in 1964; and

WHEREAS: In 1969, he co-organized the Pilot School with the Harvard School of Education and was appointed as its first coordinator and, in 1972, he became the Administrative Assistant to Oliver S. Brown, Assistant Superintendent for Business Management; and

WHEREAS: Edward Sarasin was then appointed Chairperson of the Mathematics Department, Rindge Technical School and, in 1974, he was appointed Assistant Headmaster, Rindge Technical School; and

WHEREAS: In 1976, Edward Sarasin became the Administrator of the 9th grade program and, in 1978, became the first Principal of The Cambridge Rindge and Latin High School; and

WHEREAS: Edward Sarasin has provided twenty consecutive years of leadership as Principal of CRLS; and

WHEREAS: As an educational leader, Edward Sarasin brought a new high school from its earliest difficult days to a paradigm of all the best a comprehensive public high school could be for its community; and

WHEREAS: As an educator, Edward Sarasin's philosophy has been to inspire rather than demand; to convince rather than coerce; to reason rather than argue; to suggest rather than command; to encourage rather than flatter; and to enlighten rather than prejudice; and

WHEREAS: The essence of Edward Sarasin's leadership has been the respect he manifested for all under his care by creating trust, the glue which has held CRLS together with all its varied parts; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council, on behalf of the entire Cambridge community, which has benefited from the years of commitment Edward Sarasin has provided for the betterment of our educational system, go on record showing its sincere appreciation for his immeasurable work and, upon his retirement, extend a hearty congratulations for a job well done; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Edward Sarasin on behalf of the entire City Council.
