TRT/FTC Communications, Inc., d/b/a TRT Communications, Inc., ("Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, has applied to the Department for authority to provide resold telecommunications service within Massachusetts. The applicant proposes to offer resold direct-dialed, 800 (inbound WATS) and travel card services over switched and dedicated facilities. The applicant would also offer directory assistance services.

The petitioner, TRT/FTC Communications, Inc., d/b/a TRT Communications, Inc., is required to give notice by publication hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [May 28, 1993], on the Other Common Carriers on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication no later than June 4, 1993.
