The undersigned respectfully represents that the grade of the Eastealy walk of Hancock Street, between Broadway and Harvard Street, has been recently raised, unnecessarily, and to the material damage of his estate bounding thereon and he therefore prays that the same may be lowered to a straight line drawn from the Curb at the South East corner of Harvard and Hancock St. to the Curb at the South West Corner of Broadway & Hancock St., ^{or, thereabout as may seem best} and that the said walk may be forthwith changed to conform to said new line; to this end your petitioner would like to be heard by your committee having the matter in charge.
