December 8, 1986

ORDERED: That the City Manager secure from the General Manager of the MBTA a prompt remedy for the intensely dangerous and hazardous situation which exists in both the OUTBOUND and INBOUND exits of the Central Square Red Line T Station.

These conditions exist over and above those connected with the present reconstruction.

During any substantial storm, be it snow or rain, at least 3 inches of water are allowed to remain at the bottom of the steps to the subway. While many are impacted adversely, especially the elderly, the blind and others who must cope with severe challenge are forced to wade through the water or try to get around or over it. As such, they are being subjected to risks and dangers which are unnecessary and uncalled for. Proper custodial care, including removal of the water, will solve this problem; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this Council on the resolution of this problem on or before January 5, 1987.
