Requested Route: EASTBOUND

1. From 1651 Massachusetts Avenue to Linnaean Street; on Linnaean Street to Garden Street; on Garden Street to Waterhouse Street; on Waterhouse Street to Massachusetts Avenue; on Massachusetts Avenue to Brattle Street; on Brattle Street to Elliott Street; on Elliott Street to Boylston Street; on Boylston Street to Memorial Drive; on Memorial Drive to Endicott Street; on Endicott Street to Amherst Street; on Amherst Street to Massachusetts Avenue; on Massachusetts Avenue to the Boston Line.

Requested Route: WESTBOUND

1. From Massachusetts Avenue, Boston to Amherst Street; on Amherst Street to Danforth Street; on Danforth Street to Memorial Drive; on Memorial Drive to Boylston Street; on Boylston Street to Harvard Square; thru Harvard Square to Westengard Ho.; on Westengard Ho.; to Garden Street; on Garden Street to Linnaean Street; on Linnaean Street to Massachusetts Avenue; on Massachusetts Avenue to 1651 Massachusetts Avenue.

## Proposed Service

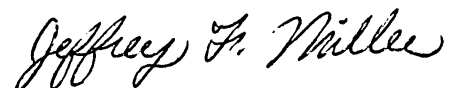
1. Service every 30 minutes.
