In Board of Aldermen, *August 3^d* 1874

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that *Milk Street* near the *Somerville* line should be widened

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on

Milk Street

as is included between the *red* lines shown on a plan of *Milk* Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *July 18th* 1874 and now before this Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said

Milk Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said *widening* be estimated
and awarded as follows:

To Lewis Sage for 523.8⁴⁹ feet of land 50^c \$261.90
" J C Bancroft " 2469⁰⁹ feet " " 1234.50

Ordered, That 40 days, be allowed to the persons whose land is
taken for said widening for the removal of Fences &c standing
on the land so taken as aforesaid.
