

1 SECT. 2. No owner, driver or other person having the care
 2 of any Truck, Cart, Wagon, Sled or other vehicle, whether
 3 used for burden or pleasure, shall stop or place such vehicle
 4 in such a manner as to cross the footing or flagstone, or
 5 obstruct or prevent foot passengers from passing or cross-
 6 ing any street, square, lane or alley, along such footing or
 7 flagstone, under a penalty of not less than three nor more
 8 than twenty dollars.

Obstructions in Streets &c

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty.

AN ORDINANCE

TO PREVENT OBSTRUCTIONS IN STREETS, BY CARRIAGES STAND-
ING THEREIN: —

*Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge,
as follows:*

1 SECT. 1. No owner, driver, or other person having the
2 care or ordering of any Chaise, Carryall, Hackney Carriage,
3 Truck, Cart, Wagon, Hand-cart, Sleigh, Sled, Hand-sled,
4 or any other vehicle whatever, new or old, finished or
5 unfinished, ~~with or without a horse or horses, or other~~
6 ~~animal or animals, harnessed thereto,~~ shall suffer the same
7 to remain standing in any street, square, lane or alley of
8 this City, more than ^{thirty} ~~five~~ minutes without some proper
9 person to take care of the same, or more than ^{sixty} ~~twenty~~ min-
10 utes in any case: and any person so offending shall be
11 liable to a fine of not less than three nor more than twenty
12 dollars for each offence. But this section shall not apply
13 to the Carriages of Physicians while visiting the sick.
