To the Honorable, the City Council:

With reference to inquiry relative to the identity of the owner of the plastic goods warehouse presently operating in the Wellington-Harrington and Model Cities Area, I have received the following information from the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority.

There appear to be four "plastics" business concerns located in the Model Neighborhood Area, as follows:

1. Data Packaging Corporation, 205 Broadway
2. Morning Star Corporation of Maine, 205 Broadway
3. Future Plastics Incorporated - 152 Columbia Street
4. Blue Bell Plastics, 17 Webster Avenue

Of these, only Blue Bell Plastics is in the Wellington-Harrington Neighborhood Improvement Area and the other three are in the Model Neighborhood Area (MNA), outside of the Wellington-Harrington Area. Blue Bell Plastics began operations about two years ago replacing a rug company. The firm receives polyethelene sheets in large flat wooden crates, unpacks and re-packages them for distribution. There does not appear to be any type of manufacturing on the premises.

The buildings containing Blue Bell Plastics are in private ownership but are designated to be acquired by the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority under the terms and conditions of the Wellington-Harrington Neighborhood Improvement Plan as approved by the City of Cambridge. The three buildings in the MNA, outside the Wellington-Harrington Area are not directly affected by the Wellington-Harrington Neighborhood Improvement Plan.
