as follows,

Section One,

Whoever frequents any
street or public place in this city and
annoys and disturbs the neighborhood
by playing on a hand-organ or any
other musical instrument, or by beating
a drum or blowing a trumpet, shall be
punished by fine of not more than
twenty dollars.
