- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Superintendent of Buildings to take the appropriate steps to insure that this public nuisance as adjudged by this Council be demolished without delay.

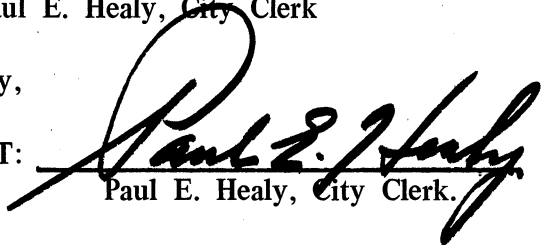
