Whereas,

It is adjudged by this board that the public necessity and convenience require that the grade of Main Street, should be changed on the southwesterly side, opposite Norfolk Street, it is therefore

Ordered,

That the grade of said Main Street, on the southwesterly side, opposite Norfolk Street, and in front of the estate of B. P. Clark, be changed in accordance with a plan drawn by the City Engineer and now before this board.

It is further

Ordered,

That there be allowed and paid to said B. P. Clark, the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars, upon the conditions hereinafter named, said sum to be in full for all claims for damages on the part of said Clark, on account of such change of grade. The Mayor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the City Treasurer in favor of the said B. P. Clark, and for the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars as aforesaid, the same to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Paving)

Provided: That before such payment shall be made, the said B. P. Clark shall execute and give to the city a satisfactory release of the land in front of his said estate, as shown on said plan, such release to be approved by the City Solicitor.

The Committee on Finance, to which was referred the matter of a proposed change of grade on the southerly side of Main Street, opposite Norfolk Street, would respectfully
Report.

This matter has been before successive City Councils, since the latter part of the year 1885. It comes to this Committee on a recent report of the Committee on Roads and Bridges, with instruction that the ways and means for completing the proposed change of grade, be provided, if their Committee shall deem it expedient. The proposed attendant upon the carrying out of the plan of the foregoing, would amount to Twelve Hundred Dollars.

Inasmuch as no provision was made for this in the annual appropriations, it is deemed by your Committee, to be inexpedient to take any further action in the matter.
