WHEREAS:-

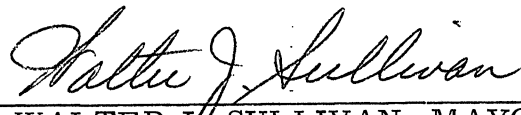
The local "Y" has programs devoted to all ages but with a special emphasis on the youth of our City; now therefore be it
