North on Main Street fifty feet, East on land now or

Joshua P. Thayer, one hundred feet, and being informed

privilege of way over a part of said land namely over

in length and about thirteen feet in width by the usual
measures more or less, between the front of the building
standing thereon or near said front and the northerly
line of said lot, hereby gives notice to said City of
Cambridge that she disputes any and all such
easement or privilege and she intends to prevent said
City from acquiring any such easement or privilege
