To the Hon^{ble} Mayor and Board of Aldermen
of the City of Cambridge. —

The undersigned, residents on and near North Avenue,
would respectfully ask leave to enclose such
portion of the area on the Northw^{est} side of
the Common on North Avenue, opposite the
corner of Waterhouse Street, between the travel-
=ed roadway as you shall deem proper
without detriment to the public travel.

Said area being now drained of
the surface water, and not needed or used
for public travel, the undersigned desire
to beautify the same with walks, trees, &c.

It may be proper to remark that
the city council of 1853 & 54 gave the
liberty to enclose, but there being no
outlet for the water it could not be carried
out. The sewer constructed last year obviates
that difficulty.
