The Joint Standing Committee on Roads & Bridges to which was referred the petition of James Bannan asking that compensation be allowed him, for damage caused by a change in the grade of Cambridge Street, at the corner of Rideout Street, respectfully

Report — That they have examined the premises & find no change in the grade of the Street; but the side walk has been built up to the proper grade which before was suffered much below the middle of the street, so that the water is now turned off & kept away from the basement door of the petitioners building, where before he suffered great inconvenience from the water flowing in, so that your Committee regard the petitioner benefitted, rather than injured, & recommend he have leave to withdraw.
