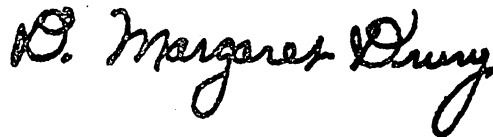

- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is committed to eliminating natural resource waste in order to improve the health of our environment and the health of our economy; and
- WHEREAS: The business community plays an important role in eliminating natural resource waste and many Cambridge businesses have already implemented a variety of solid waste management programs that include waste reduction, reuse, recycling and buying recycled materials; and
- WHEREAS: It is important to recognize these efforts which have significant positive impact on reducing Cambridge's solid waste generation; and
- WHEREAS: Abt Associates, Inc, is a business consulting firm in Cambridge with over 50 employees; and
- WHEREAS: Abt Associates, Inc is currently recycling 33% of their waste; and purchases recycled office products, and donates office equipment to local schools, and reuses shipping & packing materials, and composts their yard waste, and educates employees about their program; and
- WHEREAS: Homeowner's Rehab, Inc is a non-profit affordable housing developer in Cambridge with fewer than 50 employees; and
- WHEREAS: Homeowner's Rehab, Inc implemented a construction waste management plan for building contractors so that 50% of waste was recycled; and helped develop a recycling educational and logistical plan for the new buildings, and reused building materials, and purchased furnishings made of recycled content, now therefore be it
