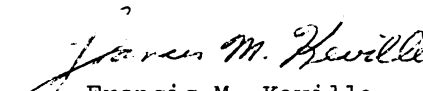

Please be informed that this office has directed its consultants and engineers to include the terms of the order in all future contracts now in preparation for advertising.

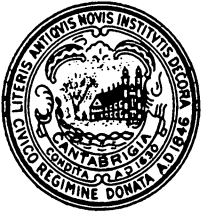

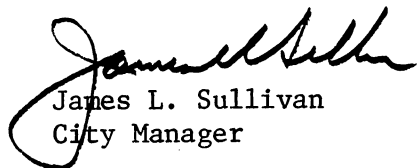
