

City of Cambridge:

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-five

An Ordinance

in addition to an Ordinance in relation to Finance,

As it is ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

The Committee on Accounts shall, immediately after the fifteenth day of each month, cause to be prepared a statement showing the amount of the various Appropriations on that day, the amount expended out of each Appropriation, and the balances remaining unexpended. The amount of all approved bills, and of all orders drawn by the Mayor, shall be included in amounts expended.

This statement, when prepared, shall be printed, and a copy thereof furnished to each member of the City Council.
